OVERVIEW

The Applied Project Risk Management (APRM) course is an introductory-level program designed to provide you with a comprehensive overview of best practices in project risk management.

This course teaches practical techniques for managing project risks that can be applied in any industry. You will learn to proactively identify, define, and assess risks, as well as plan and implement effective risk response strategies.

SYLLABUS

The course consists of:

- Course Introduction & Risk Management Planning
- Identifying Project Risks
- Performing a Qualitative Risk Analysis
- Assigning Risk Responses and Owners
- Monitoring Project Risks

OBJECTIVE

On completion of the course, you will have demonstrated in a project of your choice how to:

1. Develop a project risk management plan.
2. Identify project risks, describe them using risk metalanguage, and log them in a project risk register.
3. Use the risk management plan from outcome one to perform a qualitative analysis on the project's risks, and update the risk register accordingly.
4. For each risk, assign a suitable risk response and risk owner, provide a practical action or action plan to execute the risk response, update the risk register accordingly, and indicate which project management artifacts will be affected.
5. Monitor project risks and update, refine, or amend risk information as applicable.



FORMAT

Pre-Course Communication: Your facilitator will send out important communications, including invitations to Microsoft Teams virtual sessions for the duration of the course.

Course Kickoff:

- Virtual session to officially start the course.
- Overview of the course logic and approach.

Weekly Activities:

- Access and review the week's course material.
- Complete the quiz and assignment.
- Assignment submission deadlines will be communicated in advance.
- Facilitator reviews each assignment and provides feedback before the next virtual session.
